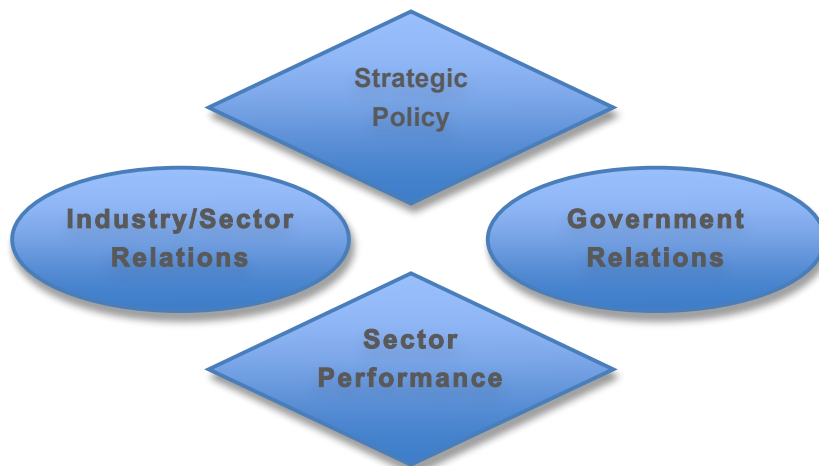


The ITF seeks a *skilled and productive New Zealand* through work in four areas: **strategic policy, government relations, industry/sector relations and sector performance.**



#### **Strategic Policy - Priorities 2011**

- Develop a clear vision for a VET system that meets industry skill needs and drives productivity
- Address VET policy inconsistencies
- Promote sector pathways for senior secondary education and beyond

#### **Government Relations - Priorities 2011**

- Establish stronger relationships at the political level
- Further develop relationships with Ministry of Education and other agencies
- Develop stronger relationship with TEC and NZQA Boards

#### **Industry/Sector Relations - Priorities 2011**

- Work with ITOs to develop key industry champions
- Work with Business NZ and NZCTU on industry training and VET reform
- Work with VET provider and sector groups to promote VET reform

#### **Sector Performance - Priorities 2011**

- Develop ITF membership policy on ITO compliance with funding rules
- Provide guidance to lift ITO performance
- Support qualifications and standards reform
